

SCRIPTURAL CONFESSION: Healing and Health

I harken to the voice of the LORD my God, and do that which is right in His sight. I give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes—so none of the diseases can be brought upon me or my family, which have been brought upon the world, for God said, 'I am the LORD that heals you.' **Exodus 15:26**

I serve the LORD my God, and He blesses my bread, and my water. He takes sickness away from me and my family. **Exodus 23:25**

God keeps all my bones: not one of them is broken. **Psalm 34:20**

Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget none of His benefits: He forgives my iniquities; He heals all my diseases; He redeems my life from destruction; and crowns me with lovingkindness and tender mercies; He satisfies my mouth with good things; so that my youth is renewed like the eagle's. The LORD executes righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed. **Psalm 103:1-6**

God sent His word, and healed me and my family, and He has delivered us from destruction. **Psalm 107:20**

Jesus bore our griefs and sicknesses, and carried our sorrows and pains. We esteem Him as the One stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted (as our substitute)—but He was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our guilt and iniquities: the chastisement needful to obtain peace and well-being was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed and made whole. **Isaiah 53:4-5**

Jesus Himself took our (my) infirmities, and bare our (my) sicknesses. **Matthew 8:17**

God has anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power. He went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him. I also go about doing good and healing all that are oppressed of the devil, for God is with me. **Acts 10:38**

The Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in me, and He that raised up Christ from the dead also quickens (energizes, makes alive and heals) my mortal body by His Spirit that dwells in me. **Romans 8:11**

Jesus Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, so that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes we were healed. **1 Peter 2:24**
