

## SCRIPTURAL CONFESSION: Children, Family and Home

*For our children we prayed; and the LORD has given us what we asked of Him. Our children are given to the LORD, and as long as they live they will be given to the LORD. 1 Samuel 1:27-28*

*All our children — (names) — shall be taught of the LORD and obedient to His will; and great is their peace and undisturbed composure. Isaiah 54:13*

*Our children obey their parents in the Lord: for this is right. They honor their father and mother, which is the first commandment with promise. Therefore it is well with them, and they will live long on the earth. I do not provoke our children to wrath: but I bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. Ephesians 6:1-4*

*I train up my children in the way they should go: and when they are old, they will not depart from it. Proverbs 22:6*

*My sons and daughters — (names) — do not forget my teaching or God's law. They let their hearts keep His commandments. For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to them. They do not let mercy and truth forsake them; they bind them about their necks and write them upon the tablets of their hearts. So will they find favor and good understanding in the sight of God and man. They trust in the LORD with all their hearts, and lean not unto their own understanding. In all their ways they acknowledge Him, and He shall direct their paths. They are not wise in their own eyes. They fear the LORD, and depart from evil. Proverbs 3:1-7*

*You, God, will not allow my children's feet to slip or to be moved, except toward you. You keep them and will not slumber. Psalm 121:3*

*The LORD is righteous. He has cut asunder the thick cords of the wicked and the wicked one. Psalm 129:4*

*The scepter of wickedness shall not rest on the land allotted of the righteous, lest we reach forth our hands to iniquity. Psalm 125:3*
